The Vernal Equinox occurs around March 20 or 21st. This is when the <u>sun</u> is directly above the equator, making the day and night equal length.

The Anglo-Saxons called March "Hlyd monath" meaning "Stormy month" or "Hraed monath" meaning "Rugged month."
